



Bridgeway 2002 Sonoma County Zinfandel

Tasting Notes:

The wine opens with dark, rich plum and raspberry aromas with creamy vanilla oak and overtones of clove, nutmeg, and spearmint. On the palate, it expresses the intense varietal character of old vine Zinfandel, with raspberry jam flavors. Ripe mid-palate tannins contribute to a lively rolling texture and the promise of further development with age. It is very well balanced with a long, luscious finish.

Composition:

100% Zinfandel, from a selection of vineyards in Sonoma County, all of which are over 80 years old. The vines are dry farmed and head pruned, with very low yields. The majority of them are organically grown.
