



2003 Caledonia Australis Pinot Noir

Caledonia Australis Vineyard awarded five star rating by James Halliday for the second year in a row. Australian Wine Companion 2006.

2003 Caledonia Australis Pinot Noir 94/100.

This is the third Estate pinot produced by Caledonia Australis and undoubtedly its best yet. Rated well by Halliday, it also won a silver medal in the 2006 Federation Square Showcase Awards for Victorian wine – no other red wine scored better. It also earned the title of best pinot at the annual pinot winemaker tasting, conducted in Tasmania in April 2006, and a Top 5 Star rating by Ralph Kyte-Powell in August 2006.

Winemaker Martin Williams describes the wine as having a 'deep raspberry/cherry colour with a mauve rim, and ripe red fruit aromas with subtle cherry/plum overtones. Spicy forest floor characters complement the regional earthiness. Generous Pinot Noir flavours fill the mouth, framed by an even, long palate structure. Fine French oak is well integrated on the nose and palate'.
