The 2001 Syrah marks the second release of this noble varietal by brothers Jim DelBondio and Rich Poncia. Opaque, dense and crimson in the glass, this Syrah exhibits the rich perfume of ripe black fruits, chocolate, leather and subtle smokiness.

On the palate, a classic expression of structured blackberries and plums harmonize with hints of vanilla, mocha, cinnamon, mint and white pepper. The sensational ripe fruit lingers alongside the texturally elegant mid-palate tannins.

While delicious to drink now, the 2001 Del Bondio Syrah is well balanced and has the tannins and acid to easily allow for 8-10 years of cellaring. 100% Syrah
