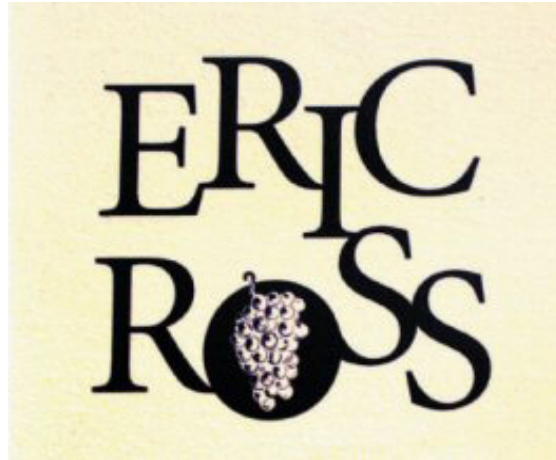




Russian Valley Pinot Noir

"Our 2001 Russian River Valley Poule d'Or Pinot Noir has a smokey nose with hints of sweet toasty French oak, as well as notes of cola and roast coffee. The mouth has a nice complexity and flavors of bing cherry and rhubarb with mouth coating tannins, and a full rich lingering finish." -Eric Luse and John Storey
