



2005 Struttin' Red California Red Wine

The Wine

Struttin' Red is a blend of Old Vine Carignane from Lodi and Petit Verdot from Lake County. The Old Vine Carignane comes from the Rauser Ranch Vineyard in Lodi. The vines were planted in 1907 giving the wine depth and complexity. The Petit Verdot adds structure to this lovely blend of Rhone and Bordeaux varietals. The garnet colored sparkles in the glass. In the nose you find bright, spring like flavors, with notes of plum and berry. As you sip Struttin' Red the flavors beg for a picnic, as it's juiciness overwhelms the palate. With soft tannins, this robust easy drinking wine is made for barbecue, lamb chops or even a grilled burger.
