Encépagement: 70 % Cabernet Sauvignon , 27 % Merlot, 2 % Petit Verdot, 1 % Cabernet Franc.

Terroir: Graves

Winemaking: French barriques, 40 % new oak. Aged for 12 months. Fined with egg whites.

Winemakers: Messieurs Eric et Jacques Boissenot

Production: 35 000 bottles

Tasting Notes: There's licorice, violet and berry on the nose, with just a hint of milk chocolate. Medium-bodied, with sweet, ripe fruit and a silky finish. A balanced wine for early drinking. Best after 2008. 2,915 cases made. –*James Suckling, Wine Spectator, 85 points*
