



Rich, red in color, this 2001 Dry Creek Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is redolent with aromas and flavors of blackberry, juicy red cherry, and fresh toasty oak. This is a full-bodied, well-balanced wine that has a thick textured palate that echoes fresh fruit flavors. Velvety firm tannins lead to a long, alluring finish.
