

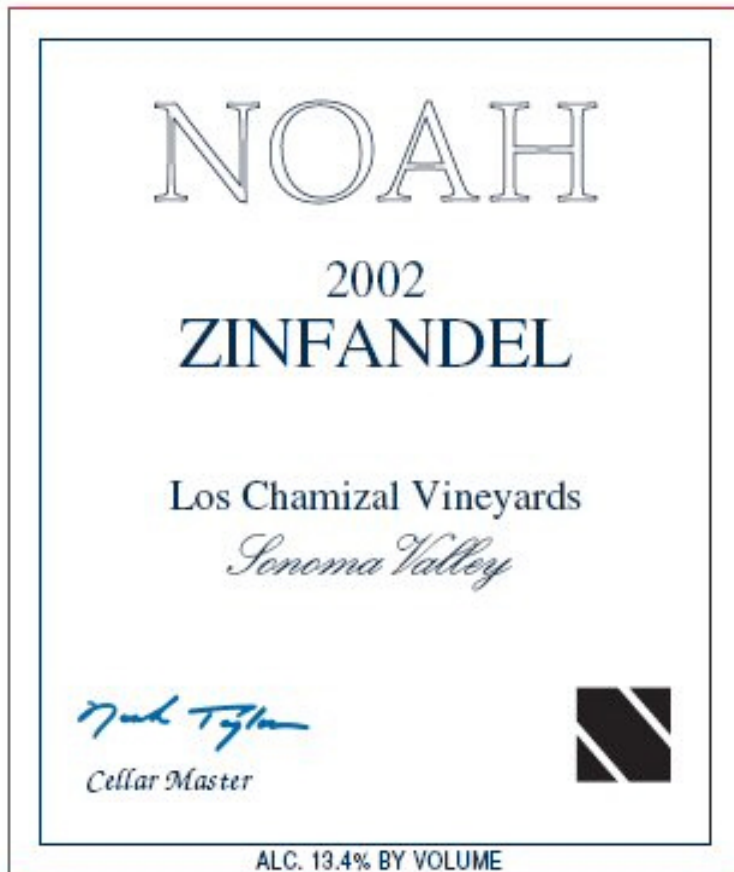


Noah Vineyards

The Noah 2002 Los Chamizal Vineyard Zinfandel, is a truly distinctive expression of this fun and uniquely California varietal. This famed vineyard is nestled in the hills above the town of Sonoma, and is the home to some of California's most exceptional Zinfandels. The deep sandy soils and warm summer days lend themselves to producing ripe, rich and full flavored wines.

The wine can pair well with grilled foods but also be enjoyed by itself on a sunny afternoon. It has a low residual sugar and forward fruit that disguise its heady structure. Aromas of mature plum and blackberry rush the senses as the soft smoky oak tannins fill the palate for a long intense finish.
