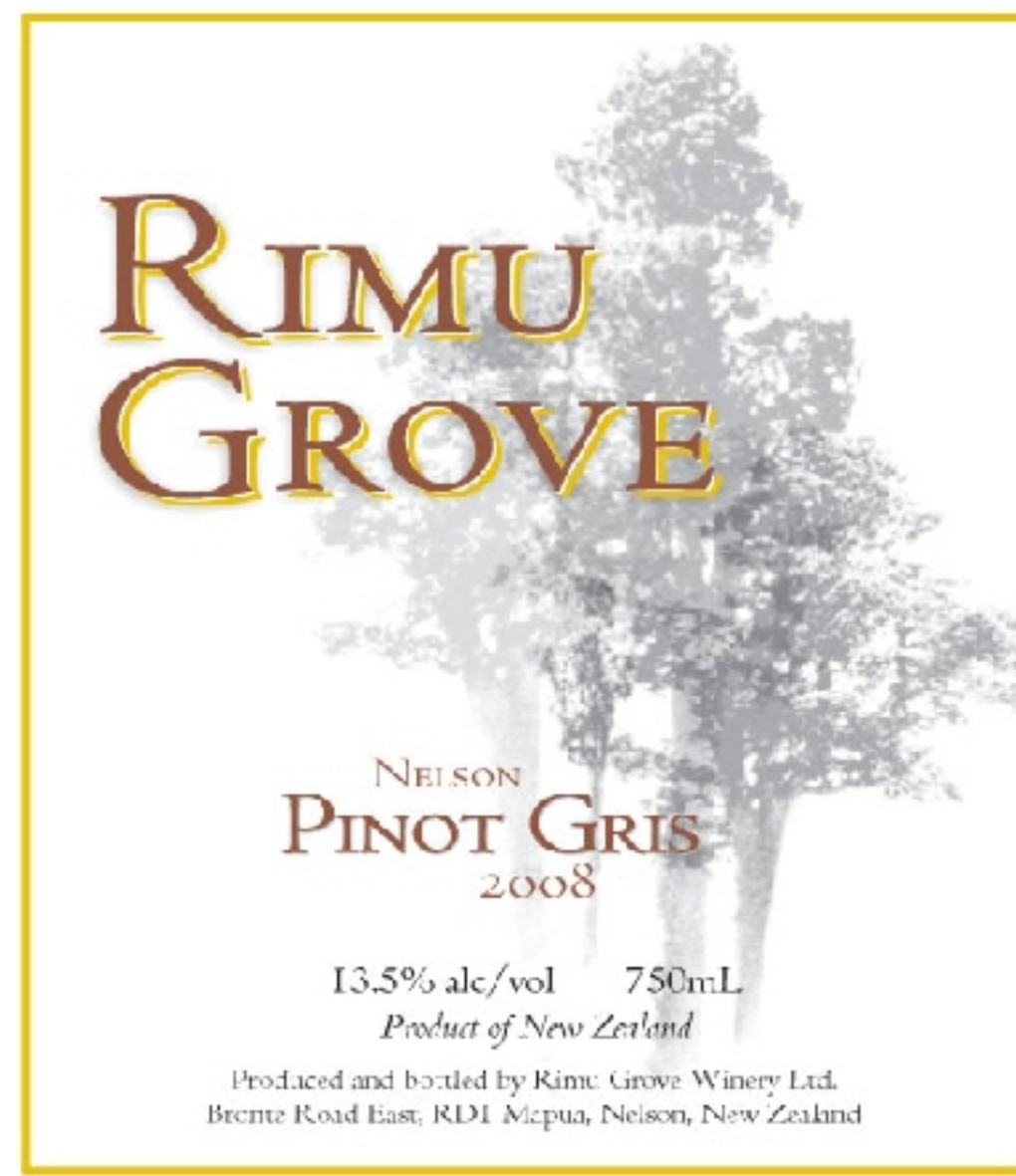

Winemaker's Notes

Harvest date:	15 – 16 April 2008
Sugars at harvest:	23.4 – 24.0 Brix
Bottling date:	22 August 2008
Cases produced:	650
Alcohol:	13.5%
Residual Sugars:	12 g/L
pH:	3.43
T/A:	5.9 g/L

This wine was produced from fruit grown in the Moutere Hills which underwent 100% whole-cluster pressing. 15% aged sur lie in aged French oak barrels for 4 months, 85% aged sur lie in stainless steel tanks.

Tasting Notes:

Concentrated Pinot Gris with strong varietal characters. Citrus blossom, pears and tropical fruit aromas and flavours combine with a firm backbone of minerality and acidity. Oily, opulent textures fill the mouth and linger on the palate.
