## Château SAINT MICHEL Bordeaux Supérieur 2005



The team at Château Nénin have done much work on the vineyard since its acquisition in 1997. Parcels of vines have been replanted and the vines go through rigorous work throughout the year. Since the 2002 vintage, Saint Michel produces a rich, concentrated, fruit-driven wine, perfect for an entry level claret.

### The Vineyard :

This small, 6 hectare, property was purchased by the Delon family of Châteaux Léoville Las Cases, Clos du Marquis, and Potensac at the same time as Château Nénin in Pomerol. Located on the border of the pretty Fronsac appellation on a clay-sand soil, the vineyard is managed and the wine is made by the team at Château Nénin.

- Surface : 6 Hectares
- Soil : Clay / Sand
- Average age of vines : 30 years
- Plantation density : 4500 vines per hectare

### Grape Varieties :

- 75 % Merlot
- 25 % Cabernet Franc

### Harvest :

- Green Harvest
- Manual grape picking
- Manual sorting table

### Ageing :

- The wine is fermented in temperature controlled cement and stainless steel vats.
- Oak aged for 12 months in the barrel cellar at Château Nénin.
